Quaker Award

- Up to \$3,000 per year
- Students must be active in a Friends Meeting and have their pastor/monthly meeting clerk send a letter of recommendation on their behalf no later than **May 1**.
- *or* - a graduate from a Quaker high school
- Student must return the Quaker Award Application to the Office of Admission no later than **March 1**.
- Available regardless of need
- The amount of this award may vary, depending upon the student's eligibility to receive other Wilmington College awards.
- Not awarded in conjunction with the Quaker Leader Scholarship.

Quaker Leader Scholarship

The Quaker Leader Scholarship is awarded to qualified students on the basis of academic achievement, prior involvement in their Friends Meeting, and willingness to actively participate in the Quaker Leader Scholar program at Wilmington College.

- Up to \$13,000 per year
- Renewable to each student who demonstrates active participation in the Quaker Leader Scholar program and who maintains at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Qualifications:

- Students must be accepted for admission to Wilmington College by **February 1**.
- Students must be active in a Friends Meeting and have their pastor/monthly meeting clerk send a letter of recommendation on their behalf no later than **May 1**.
- Students must participate in an on-campus interview process in February.
- Students must submit an essay on "What is the Quaker testimony you find most challenging and why?" Essays must be submitted to the Office of Admission at least one week prior to the on-campus interview.

Expectations:

- Students will participate in regular meetings of the Quaker Leader Scholars.
- Students will participate in activities, trips, etc.
- Students will enroll in the Introduction to Quakers course.
- Students will become increasingly involved in campus and community leadership.
- Student will perform 20 hours community service per semester.
